## Peterborough & the Kawarthas Tourism (PKT) Canada 150+ Geocaching Adventure

Join the County of Peterborough, its 8 member municipalities, 2 First Nations and the City of Peterborough as we celebrate some of the stories from our past in the places where they happened. Each community holds 2 or 3 caches with the matching stamps.

Why 150+? The “plus” recognizes that Canada’s history is built on the stories of our indigenous and non-indigenous ancestors on timelines that are broader than these past 150 years.

### **How to Complete this Adventure?**

1. Download the Travel Diary from PKT’s geocaching page.
2. Grab your GPS or smartphone and find your first cache.
3. Visit at least one cache in each of the communities named on the reverse and take an impression of the unique stamp in each community. Use the crayon or pencil supplied to take a rubbing or bring your own stamp pad.  
*(We understand if you want to visit them all. They’re pretty fun!)*
4. Collect all 11 unique impressions to be eligible for a collectible Peterborough & the Kawarthas trackable geocoin.
5. Receive your limited edition geocoin while supplies last by returning the completed Travel Diary to:
